ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a born-again believer
- Be a committed RNCC member in good standing
- Maintain a lifestyle that is consistent with scripture and demonstrates the pursuit of godliness

CLASS ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend all classes.

Attendance is tracked and calculated as part of a student's overall grade point average.

A maximum of 1 absence is permitted during a semester.

All class instructional materials and recordings will be available in the class portal in the event of absence.

The student is expected to review any missed instruction and make up any missed assignments.



REGISTRATION

Q: Is the RNCC School of Ministry accredited?

A: The RNCC School of Ministry is a non-accredited, certificate-based school of faith-based study.

Q: What does the registration fee include?

A: The registration fee covers all semester sessions, provided instructional materials, processing fees, course catalog, course workbook class portal access and processing fees. **All registration fees are non-refundable.**

Q: Why is a Gmail Email address required?

A: The RNCC School of Ministry online portal is a google based platform. In order to access it, you must have a Gmail email address. You can set one up for free at **mail.google.com** if you do not have a Gmail address.

Q: What is the RNCC School of Ministry online portal? How do I access it?

A: The online class portal is where students will retrieve, review and submit all course materials, assignments, discussion posts etc. You can also correspond directly with your instructors and classmates as well. Once your registration is complete, you will receive an email with a link to access the portal. You will also be able to access the portal via our website at www.rnccschoolofministry.org
